

LYON Ski School-Instructor Training Program

The Lyon Ski School Instructor Training Program is a development program for individuals wishing to purse employment as a professional ski or snowboard instructor. Minimum skill requirement for enrollment in the Lyon Ski School Instructor Training Program is advanced intermediate skier and/or snowboarder.

The Lyon Ski School Instructor Training Program meets the curriculum requirements for P.S.I.A. (Professional Ski Instructors of America) membership, Level I certification, PSIA Ed-credit and Lyon Ski School employment. The program includes classroom and on-snow training classes in November and December. Successful participants completing the Instructor Training Program will receive automatic consideration for employment at Lyon Ski School.

TRAINING CLASSES

Classroom sessions begin in November and on snow training sessions on the last weekend of November and weekends in December. Classes are taught by PSIA certified trainers and include: learning theory, children's growth and development, teaching techniques, class handling, ski/snowboard mechanics, personal skill development, and more.
