With almost 25 different topics included in the curriculum, participants will delve deeply into a variety of scientific topics and learn to develop and apply creative and innovative ideas together as a team. Qualified teams present their skills at regional, state, and even national level competitions. The club is also seeking parent volunteers to support students by either volunteering as a team coach or

2019-2020 Reflections Theme: Look Within

National PTA Reflections is a nationally acclaimed student recognition program to encourage artistic creativity in the classroom and at home. Categories for submissions include: Visual Arts, Literature, Photography, Music Composition, Film/Video, and Choreography/Dance.

To participate in this program, students work independently on their chosen creative work during the summer and early fall using the guidelines established by the national program. In November, Leota hosts an Art Walk displaying student submissions for the student body, and students pick their favorites in the People's Choice Awards. In January, the Northshore Council PTSA hosts an open house featuring all participants who make it to the council level and announce the submissions moving to the state level. This year's theme is
